



Matriculation & TCNJ Email





- Week of May 1-5
- Matriculation triggers the creation of your TCNJ email account and grants the rest of campus (outside of Admissions) access to you as a new student
- Your TCNJ email is the College's official communication method for all students

Placement Testing





- TCNJ administers placement tests in Second Language, Calculus, and Writing
 - Dates: Friday, May 5 Friday, May 26
- Results used to complete pre-registration of your fall schedule
- The Fall Placement & Assessment Booklet and Transfer E-Book will walk you through the steps to determine which ones you have to complete

- Application Opens: Week of May 1
- Deadline: Rolling (earlier increases your chances of placement!)
- Notification Date: Rolling, beginning on Wednesday, May 24

Pre-Entrance Health Requirements





- Required for ALL students, including those who are commuting to campus
- Not completing these requirements by the deadline will result in registration and housing holds placed on your account and late fees
- Deadline: JULY 15
- Access forms through online orientation



TCNJ ID Card Photo





- Online process for students to submit a photo for their TCNJ ID Card
- Pick Up at Orientation in July (or during move-in)
- Roscoe Tip: You need a government issued photo ID to pick up... don't forget it!

SUMMER TIMELINE: JUNE 2023

Pre-Registration

- Have your official transcripts sent over ASAP!
- Read through the Transfer E-Book FIRST! This will answer 80% of your questions.
- You are assigned an academic evaluator based on your major. This person can answer questions you have about credits transferring, etc.

- TCNJ academic departments will pre-register you for fall classes throughout the month of June, and you can confirm / change during on-campus orientation.
